Dear CCS Families,

The CCS staff are so excited to see your children return to school for a new year! Below are important highlights from the Reopening Presentation that was held last week in regards to what we are continuing to do & what changes we have been able to make in order to open the school safely. Please remember that at any time, we may need to make adjustments.

- 1. Staff & families will still need to screen for health & wellness each day before coming to school with the <u>Daily Home Screening Check</u> we used last year. Staff or students should stay home when feeling ill & follow protocols for reporting illness.
- 2. Masks are only needed to be worn inside. Students can take masks off outside as long as they socially distance from peers (6 ft or more).
- 3. Inside the classroom students can be 3 ft from each other this year instead of 6 ft with masks on. Areas outside of the classroom, they still need to be 6 ft.
- 4. Vaccinated students & staff no longer need to quarantine (if asymptomatic). Any student seated at least 3 ft. away from a positive student case no longer needs to quarantine if exposure was limited to a classroom setting (assuming contact is asymptomatic & consistent/correct mask use) All other quarantine restrictions remain in place, including those that should be followed after travelling out of the State of CT.
- 5. There is no distance learning this year per CT DOE. If a student has to quarantine they will be able to access work via Google Classroom/ Seesaw or work provided by teachers. There will be no live streaming into a classroom.
- 6. All staff need to prove fully vaccinated status or proof that full vaccination will occur per the Governor by Sept 27th. They can prove exemption -medical or religious supported by the submission of required documentation.
- 7. No visitors during the school day. Only staff, students & outside providers (OT, PT, counseling) will be allowed in. HOWEVER, we can have after school hours events such as Open House. Of course this may change if positive cases arise.
- 8. Middle School sports will occur for grades 7 & 8.
- 9. Cohorting is recommended but not mandated. CCS will cohort during the day by grade levels. Students will be able to travel to rooms such as art, music, etc. We will also have K-4 at recess together as well as 5-8.

Below is the link to the presentation. This is going to be another year that we need to be flexible, patient & understand that changes may occur in order to keep students & staff safe. I am confident that we will have a great year of learning by supporting each other & staying strong.
